Friday 12th May 2023 "Mock Round for international participants"

A mock round for International participants will be conducted On Socratives. Participants will be informed to join a WhatsApp group link via email loop.

Saturday 13th May 2023 "Qualifying Round and Quiz Round I&2 for International participants (On- line)"

Qualifying Round and Quiz Round I &2 for International participants (On-line) will be conducted on 2 PM (Pakistan Standard Time). Participants will be informed to join a WhatsApp group link via email loop.

Qualifying round will be held if there will be more than 25 international teams.

Round 1:

Round 1 will be conducted on http://socrative.com/ starting at **2 pm** sharp Pakistan Standard Time, participants are directed to log in 15 minutes before the starting time at 1.45 pm. There will be negative marking (-2 for a wrong answer & -1 for leaving an answer blank). All registered teams will participate in round 1. The team members can discuss among themselves but only one member of the team will log in to compete in first round.

Round 2: Top nine teams from round I will participate in Round II

Top 3 teams will qualify for **Final Round** which will be held on 27th May 2023 on zoom.

<u>Friday 26th May, 2023 "Qualifying Round (Round 1), Round 2 and Semi Final Round for National participants (On Campus)"</u>

Qualifying Round and First 2 Rounds of the quiz will be played for National participants (On Campus).

Round 1:

From 10 AM (Pakistan Standard Time), Qualifying Round (Round 1) consisting of 50 MCQs will be played with the response time of 30 seconds per MCQ.

All registered teams will participate in Round 1. The team members can discuss among themselves but only one member of the team will solve OMR sheet in first round.

From 11 AM (Pakistan Standard Time), the scores of all teams will be analyzed. Result will be announced and top 25 teams will be picked. The other teams will witness the remaining quiz as participants/attendees.

Round 2

25 Winning teams out of the registered teams from Round 1 will participate in Round 2.

25 teams will be divided into 5 groups.

5 winning teams from round 2 with 4 best scoring teams from remaining 20 will compete in semi-final round. 9 Semi Finalist teams will compete in Semi-Final Round.

Semi Final Round (Individual Effort)

9 teams will be divided into 3 groups

3 winning teams will qualify for the final round with international participant teams

They will also be considered as Top Three National champions

(Saturday 27th May, 2023) Final Round (Online)

"TOP 3 NATIONAL &INTERNATIONAL TEAMS"

On Saturday 27th May, 2023, the quiz will be played online for both top 3 National and top 3 International teams

Final Round will start at 3 PM Pakistan Standard Time on Zoom.

Zoom link will be shared with the participants

There will be 6 Finalist teams competing in the Final Round.

This Round will require Individual effort by each member of a team.

Each member of a team will be tagged as A, B or C. So team 1 will be 1A 1B 1C. For the first three Questions, 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A, 5A and 6A students from the six teams will respond to the same question.30 seconds will be the response time.

Within 30 seconds, the students are expected to write on a white chart paper prominently with black permanent marker. (Please make arrangements)

All the 6 students will display their answers together and a screen shot will be saved by Organizers. The key of each question will be revealed and explained by the Quiz master to give feedback.

3 marks will be given for the correct complete answers (if there are 2 parts to the question, both parts must be correct to be given the 3 marks).

The decision of Quiz master together with the judges will be considered as Final. Decision will be made entirely on the written answers; no verbal clarification will be entertained. illegible handwriting is obviously a handicap!

For The next three Questions, 1B, 2B, 3B, 4B, 5B and 6B students from the six teams will respond to the same question.

Similarly, for the next three Questions, 1C, 2C, 3C, 4C, 5C and 6C students from the six teams will respond to the same question.

There will be a total of 9 questions for the Final Round.

In case of a tie to decide the winner of first position, extra questions will be asked to decide the Winner of the 4th INTER MEDICAL COLLEGE PHYSIOLOGY QUIZ 2023"
